

Camassia's Most Wanted Weeds

Please report these plants!



Garlic Mustard can be found year-round in forest understory, forest edges, shaded roadside, urban areas, riparian areas, floodplains, and on agricultural lands. The leaves emit a garlicky odor when crushed.



False Brome is found in coniferous forest understory, riparian forest understory, forest edges, and upland prairies.



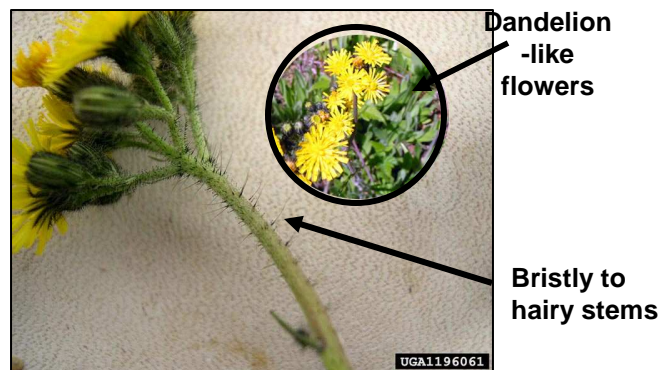
Shining Geranium can be found from spring until late July in shady, disturbed fields.



Herb Robert can be found in the winter, but flowers are present in mid to late summer. It can be found in moist forests and on dry, rocky outcrops.

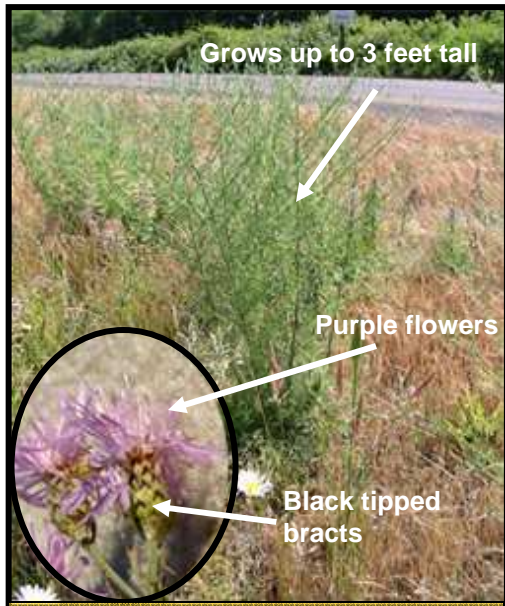


Medusahead Rye is a slender annual grass. It is found in late spring through fall in disturbed site, grasslands and oak woodlands. It browns mid-summer.



Look for **hawkweeds** in late May until September in open areas and modified habitats.

(More weeds on the back)



Grows up to 3 feet tall

Purple flowers

Black tipped bracts

Spotted Knapweed is found July through October in open areas such as pastureland or open forests



Yellow flowers have eight pedals

Shiny dark green leaves

Kidney-shaped leaves

Lesser Celandine is found in moist forested floodplains, drier upland areas, sandy soils.



flowers white and feathery during seeding

greenish-white flower clusters

Old Man's Beard is a woody vine found along roadsides, riverbanks, gardens, hedges, shelter belts, disturbed forest, or forest edges.



alternate and spirally arranged leaves

Yellow-green bell shaped flowers emit honey fragrance

Spurge Laurel is an evergreen shrub 2-5 ft tall. It blooms March through May and can be found along roadsides and in open, moist woods in the lowlands.

WARNING: TOXIC



small yellow flowers from May to June

silver-white scales on underside of leaf

small red berries from September to October

Autumn Olive is a deciduous tree found in fields and disturbed areas.
